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#### **Question 8** (8 marks)

Figure 10 is a line drawing of a hair dryer that you are required to render in colour.

The arrow indicates the direction of the light. You may refer to the images below of relevant surfaces materials to assist you. (Larger images are available in the resource booklet).

- use the light source as indicated by the arrow to enhance the form
- include cast **shadows** on the hairdryer
- use **tone** and **colour** to render the sections of the hairdryer to indicate the following surface materials: (see labelled diagram below to assist you)
  - o shiny silver plastic for the front half
  - o coloured plastic for the back and handle
  - Smooth rubber for the inner grip and chord connector
  - o Textured rubber for the button
